At Cannonvale State School, swimming is one of the core components of the Health and Physical Education curriculum for students. Living in an environment where water activities are very much a part of our way of life, it is important that students learn to swim and then progress to become competent swimmers with basic knowledge of lifesaving techniques.

It is expected that all students will participate unless there is a medical condition that may preclude this, whether on a temporary or permanent basis.

There is a charge per student for participation in the swimming program to cover costs of employing extra staff and pool maintenance. These charges will be advised at the beginning of each swimming term.

Permission can be withdrawn at any time. Please note that a letter signed by a parent advising of any medical condition will be required should any of your children be unable to participate for any period of time, whether for one lesson or several.
