As part of the Japanese program at Cannonvale State School, we participate in Skype sessions with schools in Japan where they learn English as part of their curriculum. Skype is used as a whole class to have live conversations with students in Japan. These Skype sessions occur during class time and students discuss curriculum related topics.
